

RUBY CELEBRATION QUILT SHOW

October 1 and 2, 2021

We held our first zoom meeting on March 24 for the official kick-off of our Ruby Celebration Quilt Show. We discussed a variety of issues to update the committee on activities that have already taken place, such as Save-the-Date bookmark distribution and finalizing the quilt show budget.

There will be changes to the quilt entry form. You may send in your form through the mail as we have done in previous years, however now you will be able to submit the quilt entry form on-line. And if you are having the quilt judged, you may pay the \$5 fee through PayPal. More to come on this.

Linda Lydecker is setting up a system to fill volunteer slots online since we will not be meeting live until September. We discussed at length how to communicate with the guild members so that everyone will know about the areas where we are expecting donations such as Silent Auction and Penny Raffle.

Penny Raffle Baskets: We encourage everyone (either alone or with a group) to donate a penny raffle basket filled with lots of good things. It's always best to have a theme such as chocolate, Red Sox, baby baskets, cat or dog baskets, etc. Note: the baskets need not be quilt-themed. The baskets need to be wrapped in cellophane with a note attached, listing the items in the basket. The baskets can be dropped off on Thursday at the Hope Church. The Penny Raffle is being chaired by Mary Lou Monteiro and Margaret Tipton.

Silent Auction: We are planning on having a varied and distinctive offering of silent auction items and that depends on you. Handmade items generate the most bids but all items will be accepted. Your donation should be valued at \$30 or more. The items can be dropped off on Thursday at the Hope Church. The Silent Auction is being chaired by Susan Nelson and Gigi Badolato.

It takes a lot of people to make a quilt show successful which is why MVQ has a rule that each member must volunteer a minimum of 2 hours in connection with our show to remain a member in good standing. This year we are using an online system called Sign Up Genius and you can access it via a link under the Quilt Show tab on our website. In Sign Up Genius you can easily see what slots are available. Later, if your plans change or you want to work another shift, you can edit or add to your signup. All volunteers are admitted to the show for free no matter what day they work or what day they attend the show.

MVQ 2021 Challenge

“Bright Sunshiny Day”

Hello Ladies!

Since the response from the jelly roll challenge was so positive, are you ready for another one? I hope so! The idea for this challenge came to me while I was vacationing in Aruba over the holidays. It's time to create something bright and sunshiny!

This is how it will work:

- The theme is bright and sunshiny.
- A kit containing two fat quarters and a small embellishment will be mailed to anyone wanting to participate. Each kit will have the same fat quarters. Kits can be picked up at The Red Barn in Merrimac. Hours are Wednesday through Saturday 11:00 am – 3:00pm.
- Quilt top must contain both fabrics from the kit. You can use all or some of each fat quarter.
- Size – 24” x 36” minimum. If you want to go bigger – great!
- The quilt top must have the embellishment placed on it. It can be easily removed when the top is ready to be quilted. Entries do not have to be quilted.
- All entries will be anonymous.
- Email me a picture of your quilt top.
- I will email you a secret code to identify your quilt. I will maintain a spreadsheet of all entries.
- Start date will be February 19th. End date will be April 19th.
- Quilts will be judged on best use of color, best overall design, and best visual impact.
- Gift certificates will be awarded to the winner of each category.
- Judges will review the entries with results by April 30th.
- Judges will only see a picture of your quilt and your secret code.
- Please no posts on social media until after the results are in.
- If you want to participate, please call or email me to let me know if you would like your kit mailed or if you're going to pick it up at the Red Barn.
