

## MVQ 2025-2026: Phone bag - Workshop

If you're joining us on the bus trip and prefer to use your own materials, the list of what you'll need is included below.

After making this bag a few times (and realizing it can eat up a whole afternoon), we've decided it's time to sprinkle a little efficiency magic into the project. During the January and February meetings, we'll send you home with some of the materials so you can get a head start. Your "homework" adventure will be to quilt the main body of the bag and bias binding for the handle.

### **Material required if you want to use your own fabrics:**

1. Main and coordinating fabrics: one fat quarter of each (for the main body and zippered pocket)
2. Neutral Thread to match the fabrics selected.
3. Foot needed for assembly - walking foot, zipper foot, Teflon foot (if you have one), regular foot.

### **Items that we will be supplying:**

1. Soft and stable or thick batting - used for the main body and zippered pocket
2. Light weight mesh – used for back packet to hold larger item such as phone
3. Clear vinyl – used for top front pocket
4. Fold-over elastic – used for the mesh pocket
5. Zipper - Used for the bottom pocket
