

**Merrimack Valley Quilt Guild**  
**Mystery Quilt for Program Year 2025-2026**

Welcome back! I hope you are excited as I am for another exciting year of programs and fellowship with the members of MVQG. We are so blessed to have such a fabulous guild.

This year's mystery quilt is much more basic than last year's quilt. There are no Y or partial seams, applique, half square triangles or flying geese. 😊 The finished quilt is a throw size finishing about 50" x 77". All seams will be ¼ inch. Yardage requirements assume 40/41 inches of usable fabric (WOF). The designer used scraps from her stash and only provided rough estimates. I have calculated the yardage based on the cutting instructions. The requirements for the accent and background include a small amount of extra just in case. All fabrics touch each other so a good contrast is helpful. Thank you for participating.

**Focus fabric:**

½ yard or 24 5-inch square focus blocks

**Background fabric**

2 ¾ yards

**Accent fabric**

1 ⅛ yards

**Binding**

1/2 to 2/3 yard depending on your desired binding width.

The quilt designer has authorized use of this pattern to quilt guilds. The pattern name and designer will be provided in the last set of instructions.

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Month 2

**Background fabric:**

Cut 10 - 1.5 inch by width of fabric (WOF) strips

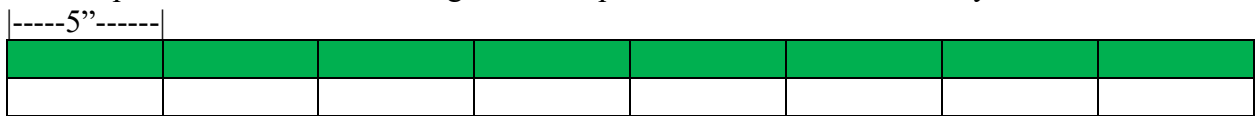
**Accent fabric:**

Cut 10 - 1.5 inch by width of fabric (WOF) strips

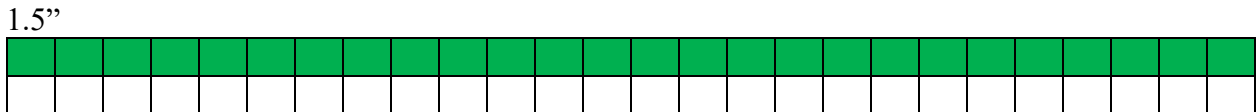
Sew 1 accent strip to 1 background strip. Repeat for all 10 strips. Press towards the dark side.



Sub cut **9** of the sewn strips into 5" rectangles. You should be able to yield 8 - 5" rectangles from each strip. Cut a total of **68** rectangles. These pieces should measure 2.5" by 5".



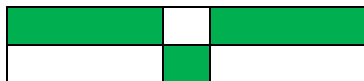
Sub cut the remaining strip into 1.5" pieces. Cut a total of **34** pieces. These pieces should measure 1.5" by 2.5".



Sew 1 5" rectangle to 1 1.5" piece as shown below. Press towards the 1.5" piece. Repeat to yield 34 blocks.



Sew 1 5" rectangle to the opposite side as shown below. Press towards the 1.5" piece. Your block will measure 2.5" by 10.5".



Label these 34 "block 1".

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Month 3

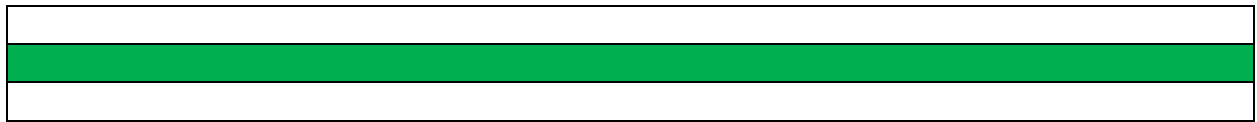
**Background fabric:** (white)

Cut 10 - 1.5 inch by width of fabric (WOF) strips

**Accent fabric:** (green)

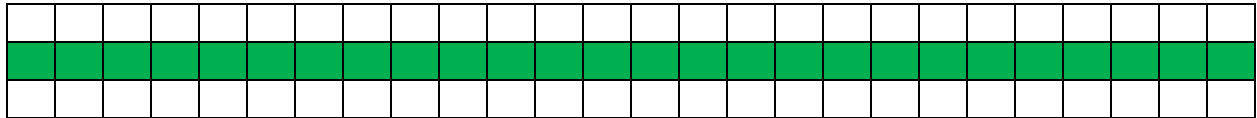
Cut 8 - 1.5 inch by width of fabric (WOF) strips

Sew a background strip to each side of an accent strip. Press to the dark side. Make **4** of these strip sets.



Sub cut each strips into 1.5" pieces. Cut a total of **96** pieces. These pieces should measure 1.5" by 3.5". **Unit A**

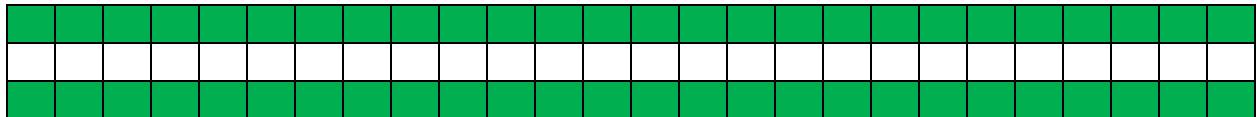


Sew an accent strip to both sides of a background strip. Press to the dark side. Make **2** of these strip sets.

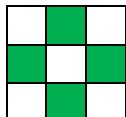


Sub cut each strips into 1.5" pieces. Cut a total of **48** pieces. These pieces should measure 1.5" by 3.5". **Unit B**

Sew 2 Unit A's and 1 Unit B together to make a 9 patch. Block should measure 3.5" x 3.5". Make **48** blocks. Label these "block 2".



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
