


Merrimack Valley Quilt Guild
Mystery Quilt for Program Year 2025-2026

Month 5

Sew 1 block 5 to 1 block 6. Make 48 and label as “block 7”.




Background fabric:

Cut 3 - 10.5 inch strips.

Sub cut into 3.5 rectangles. If you have 42 inches of usable fabric, you should be able to get 12 rectangles per strip. You need to cut a total of 34.

Sew 1 3.5 x 10.5 inch strip to block 1. Make 34 and label as “block 8”.



Background fabric:

Cut 1 – 5 inch strip.


Sub cut into 1.5 inch rectangles. You will need a total of 24 rectangles.

Accent fabric:

Cut 1 – 1.5 inch strip. You may have left over 1.5 strips from a previous step so look through your scraps before cutting a fresh strip.

Sub cut 1.5 inch squares. You need a total of 6.

Gather your 24 – 5 inch focus fabric squares and assemble the block as shown below. Make 6 and label as “block 9”.
